Proposed Consent Agreement

The Commission agreed to dismiss the complaint of Wisconsin Power and Light Company against Fischer Excavating, Inc. (Respondent) by joint execution of a consent agreement between the Commission and the Respondent. and accepted the proposed consent agreement as drafted which assesses a forfeiture against the Respondent of \$6,250 and a \$625 surcharge to Diggers Hotline, Inc.

The Commission directed the Division of Energy Regulation and Analysis to draft an order consistent with its discussion.
