The Commission approved the minutes of the open meeting of Thursday, September 19, 2024.

**3270-TE-120 - Application of Madison Gas and Electric Company for Approval of a Commercial Electric Vehicle Charging Allowance Pilot Program Tariff**

The Commission approved the Notice of Investigation and directed it to be signed by the Secretary to the Commission.

**4220-EI-111 - Request of Riverfront Properties, for a Waiver of Wis. Admin. Code § PSC 113.0803(3) Regarding Individual Electric Meters**

The Commission approved the Notice of Investigation and directed it to be signed by the Secretary to the Commission.

**6260-CE-106 - Application of the Village of Waunakee, Dane County, Wisconsin, as an Electric Public Utility, for Authority to Construct the Division Street Substation and Hogan Road Conductor Upgrades Project, in the Village of Waunakee, Dane County, Wisconsin**

The Commission approved the Notice of Investigation and directed it to be signed by the Secretary to the Commission.

**1615-WR-103 - Application of the Ledgeview Sanitary District No. 2, Brown County, Wisconsin, as a Water Public Utility, for Authority to Adjust Water Rates**

The Commission approved the Notice of Proceeding and directed it to be signed by the Secretary to the Commission.

**1675-WR-102 - Application of the Downsville Sanitary District No. 1, Dunn County, Wisconsin, as a Water Public Utility, for Authority to Adjust Water Rates**

The Commission approved the Notice of Proceeding and directed it to be signed by the Secretary to the Commission.

**6260-TW-102 - Application of the Village of Waunakee, Dane County, Wisconsin, as a Water Public Utility, for Approval to Add an Additional Meter Charge Tariff (Schedule Am-1) and Modify its Public Fire Protection Service Tariff (Schedule F-1)**

The Commission approved the Notice of Proceeding and directed it to be signed by the Secretary to the Commission.

**6630-CG-140 - Application of Wisconsin Electric Power Company for a Certificate of Authority under Wis. Stat. § 196.49 and Wis. Admin. Code § PSC 133.03 to Construct a New Liquefied Natural Gas Facility and Associated Natural Gas Pipelines in the City of Oak Creek, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin**

The Commission approved the Notice of Proceeding and directed it to be signed by the Secretary to the Commission.

**5-EI-157 - Investigation of Parallel Generation Purchase Rates**

The Commission deferred a determination as to whether to direct the preparation of a Wisconsin-specific Value of Solar Study (VOSS) and did not further identify the scope of other non-VOSS net-metering topics to be addressed in this docket at this time, but instead instructed to Commission staff to review and solicit stakeholder comments on the VOSS literature review being completed by Berkeley Lab, and to return both matters to the Commission upon completion of that process.

**1-IC-561 - Application for Intervenor Compensation filed by 350 Wisconsin to Participate in Docket 3270-UI-101**

The Commission approved the request of 350 Wisconsin for intervenor compensation in the amount of \$16,603 for its participation in docket 3270-UI-101.

The Commission directed the Division of Energy Regulation and Analysis to draft an order consistent with its discussion.

**1-IC-562 - Application for Intervenor Compensation filed by 350 Wisconsin to Participate in Docket 6680-UI-100**

The Commission approved the request of 350 Wisconsin for intervenor compensation in the amount of \$16,603 for its participation in docket 6680-UI-100.

The Commission directed the Division of Energy Regulation and Analysis to draft an order consistent with its discussion.

**1-IC-564 - Application for Intervenor Compensation filed by Blacks for Political and Social Action of Dane County to Participate in Docket 3270-UI-101**

The Commission partially funded the request of Blacks for Political and Social Action of Dane County (BPSA) to participate in docket 3270-UI-101, reducing the amount of intervenor compensation requested for legal counsel by 50 percent, directing BPSA to submit a revised work plan consistent with this partial award, and delegating approval of the revised work plan to the Administrator for the Division of Business and Operations Management.

The Commission directed the Division of Energy Regulation and Analysis to draft an order consistent with its discussion.

**1-IC-565 - Application for Intervenor Compensation filed by Blacks for Political and Social Action of Dane County to Participate in Docket 6680-UI-100**

The Commission partially funded the request of Blacks for Political and Social Action of Dane County (BPSA) to participate in docket 6680-UI-101, reducing the amount of intervenor compensation requested for legal counsel by 50 percent, directing BPSA to submit a revised work plan consistent with this partial award, and delegating approval of the revised work plan to the Administrator for the Division of Business and Operations Management.

The Commission directed the Division of Energy Regulation and Analysis to draft an order consistent with its discussion.

**4220-GP-2023 - Northern States Power Company-Wisconsin Gas Supply Plan for the Period Beginning November 1, 2023**

The Commission directed that a letter of reprimand be issued to Northern States Power Company-Wisconsin (NSPW) for violation of the Order in docket 5-GI-106 dated February 2, 1998, and Schedule GCR-1.3. NSPW is permitted to recover costs associated with contracts through the purchased gas recovery mechanism.

The Commission directed the Division of Energy Regulation and Analysis to draft a letter of reprimand consistent with its discussion.

**6680-AF-107 - Request of Wisconsin Power and Light Company for Deferral of Construction Cost Overruns Associated with Solar Generation Projects Authorized in Docket 6680-CE-182 and 6680-CE-183**

The Commission approved the proposed draft Final Decision on Reopening as written, including the proposed Citizens Utility Board order conditions and directed it to be signed by the Secretary to the Commission.
