NOTICE IS GIVEN that the Commission will hold an in-person workshop in this investigation on Tuesday, January 11, 2022 at 8:30 a.m., in the Public Service Commission Conference Room N108, located on the first floor at the Hill Farms State Office Building, 4822 Madison Yards Way, Madison, Wisconsin.

This in-person workshop will facilitate education and dialogue between all interested parties on considerations and options associated with the pursuit of performance-based regulation. The workshop will address experience with performance-based regulation in other states and address performance-based regulation options associated with a range of topics, including but not limited to customer affordability.

In its Order of September 23, 2021, the Commission ordered that a workshop be held to facilitate greater understanding and engagement on issues related to performance-based regulation, and specified that the workshop should explore regulatory options related to customer affordability. This workshop will focus on the following question:

- **What are appropriate methods and strategies for using performance-based regulation to support better performance outcomes for Wisconsin utilities?**

The workshop will review this question as applied to customer affordability as well as other topics under the Commission's jurisdiction. Input will be collected from all participants through group discussion.
