NOTICE IS GIVEN that the Commission will hold an in-person workshop in this investigation on Tuesday, June 7, 2022 at 12:30 p.m., in Conference Room N108 located on the first floor at the Hill Farms State Office Building, 4822 Madison Yards Way, Madison, Wisconsin.

On January 11, 2022, the Commission held an in-person workshop to facilitate education and dialogue on considerations and options associated with the pursuit of performance-based regulation. In its Order of April 18, 2022, the Commission ordered Commission staff to facilitate further action to address performance-based regulation through one or more additional workshops. The Commission also expressed interest in three individual topics for further attention: customer affordability, energy efficiency, and demand response. On May 6, 2022, a Notice of Intent to Hold Workshops was issued which requested public comments on how future workshops might be approached and advised that a Notice of Workshop for each future workshop would be issued as dates were identified.

This June 7, 2022, workshop will facilitate discussion regarding the identification and appropriate definition of goals for performance-based regulation, with some focus on the Commission's three topics of interest. Future workshops, as well as research and requests for public input, will draw on findings from this workshop to discuss specific objectives and metrics for consideration under a performance-based regulation framework.
