NOTICE IS GIVEN that the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin (Commission) will hold an in-person workshop in this investigation on Tuesday, August 16, 2022, at 12:30 p.m., in Conference Room N133/N134 located on the first floor at the Hill Farms State Office Building, 4822 Madison Yards Way, Madison, Wisconsin.

In its Order of April 18, 2022 in this docket, the Commission ordered Commission staff to facilitate further action to address performance-based regulation through one or more workshops. The Commission also expressed interest in three-individual topics for further attention: (1) customer affordability, (2) energy efficiency, and (3) demand response. On June 7, 2022 the Commission held the first in a planned series of workshops, which facilitated discussion regarding the identification and appropriate definition of goals and outcomes for performance-based regulation.

The August 16, 2022 workshop will seek to establish a shortened, refined list of goals and outcomes, and initiate discussion on the appropriate identification and definition of individual metrics that can be used to measure performance on those goals and outcomes.

Two future workshops are planned in the series to continue discussion of appropriate performance-based regulation metrics and to identify a final set of performance-based regulation proposals for Commission consideration. Expected workshop dates are October 13, 2022 and December 6, 2022. Future notices of workshop will be issued to confirm those dates and provide further details on the design of each individual workshop.
