Re: Application of the City of Waterloo, Jefferson County,

Wisconsin, as a Water Public Utility, for Approval to Add Non-Standard Meter Service Tariff (Schedule NSM-1)

Dear Mr. Sorenson:

On January 15, 2024, the Waterloo Water and Light Commission (applicant) submitted a request to add a new Schedule NSM-1, Non-Standard Meter Service, set at \$24.58 per month. (PSC REF#: 488935.) The applicant is a combined utility that also provides electricity service. The applicant added a new schedule NSM-1 for electric customers through docket 6220-TE-107, effective on March 1, 2022. (PSC REF#: 430781.) That docket authorized a monthly charge of \$24.58 for non-standard meter service for electric customers. The requested tariff change will ensure the charges are consistent for all electric and water customers.

The Commission has considered the applicant's request and finds it to be just and reasonable. Accordingly, Commission staff added a new Schedule NSM-1. A copy of the new schedule is attached for reference. The new tariff sheet will be placed on file at the Commission under Amendment 44 with an effective date of March 1, 2024. On such date, the applicant will implement Schedule NSM-1 at a rate of \$24.58 per month.

Please note that the applicant shall make this tariff change available to the public at locations where customer payments are accepted, on the applicant's website, or in a form and place that is otherwise readily accessible to the public, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 196.19. If copies of the new tariff are not made available to the public by one day before the effective date, the new tariff provision shall take effect one day after the date they are made available to the public.

Please update the applicant's current tariff by inserting a printed copy of the new tariff sheet into the current tariff books. Mark any old rates as "Superseded" and keep them permanently in a separate file pursuant to Wis. Admin. Code § 185.19. The applicant's current rates and rules must be available for public inspection and review at all the applicant's bill payment stations and at area libraries, pursuant to Wis. Admin. Code § 185.22. Non-Standard Meter Service

The utility shall assess a charge of \$24.58 per month to a customer who is provided service under Schedule Mg-1 and who requests a non-standard meter. The utility may only charge a customer one NSM charge for customers with both water and electric services.

If a customer establishes service at a new location on which a standard meter is installed, and the customer requests non-standard meter service, the utility shall assess the customer a one-time charge, based on actual utility costs, for the installation of a non-standard meter.

If a customer requests initial service at a location where a non-standard meter is installed, the utility may not assess a charge for installing a standard meter. The utility may not charge an existing customer who chooses to convert from a non-standard meter to a standard meter.

Billing: Same as Schedule Mg-1.
